## **Additional Shooting Terms & Conditions and General Information**

*All bookings are subject to the standard Terms & Conditions of booking. Individuals undertaking in shooting activities are also subject to the additional conditions contained here-within.*

*Please ensure that you read through both sets of terms and conditions comprehensively and then sign your booking form to confirm your acceptance.*

### **Booking & Cancellations**

All conditions are as stated in the standard terms and conditions and include those stated in any general correspondence relating to the booking.

### **Liability & Insurance**

All individuals participating in shooting activities (with the exception of clay pigeon shooting) must have their own valid 3rd party insurance in place. Clients should recognise that there is an element of risk associated with shooting activities. It is strongly advised that you arrange your own personal injury insurance as Killean Estate will not accept any liability for injuries sustained. All guns must have a valid license and this must be provided to the Gamekeeper on demand.

### **Stalking**

All game and venison shot is the property of the estate. As a general rule, a fair chance at a Roe Buck counts if a clear shot is possible at a range of up to 120 metres and for a stag up to 180 metres. However, if a client chooses to shoot at any range, that decision is his responsibility. Killean Estate reserves the right to make a charge for wounded but not recovered deer - the estate reserves the right to count these as deer shot. All stalking clients must satisfy the Gamekeeper they are capable of shooting a target with reasonable accuracy - the estate reserves the right to cancel or postpone stalking with no right to refunds if the rifle is unable to perform satisfactorily to the target.

### **Trophies**

When preparing trophies for Roe & Stags, we will normally cut the heads long or short nose. The cleaning of the heads is only sufficient for Customs & Airline regulations so that most of the meat and soft tissue is removed. If clients wish trophies to be cleaned and prepared more thoroughly or require full head uncut, they should ask the Gamekeeper if this is possible, or take them home and use a local taxidermist for the final bleaching and cleaning.

### **Bags**

Bag expectations are subject to reasonable accuracy of the guns. All grouse days are subject to our July/August count of birds. If there are insufficient birds, we reserve the right to cancel shooting (we usually inform you by the end of July or early August, but this can sometimes be later if conditions change). We would give you a full refund minus any weapon permit fees and/or small accommodation deposits if they apply.

When shooting and stalking, an increasing number of clients demand precise expectations and corresponding success. Our game is wild and unpredictable. Please note, that figures and expectations are given in good faith and that all expectations are averages and assume a certain standard of fitness and ability of the hunters as well as weather conditions conducive to that particular sport. If clients lose time on all or part of a shooting or stalking day due to their delay, illness or other reason or choose to cancel any stalking outings, the estate will do its best to provide the sport and expectation booked, but there can be no redress against Killean Estate or its employees.

### **Conduct**

We politely request that all individuals respect the advice and instructions issued by our Gamekeeper. We expect all individuals participating in shooting activities to abide by all the relevant BASC Codes of Practice, to respect the land and all growing crops, livestock and equipment and to behave in a suitable sportsmanlike manner. We reserve the right to cancel any shooting activity with immediate effect, with no refund given, for any gun(s) behaving in an unsportsmanlike or dangerous manner. Killean Estate reserves the right to refuse participation to clients we believe have been or are still under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
